LAMU COUNTY: Six police officers killed, three injured and two missing after their truck ran over an improvised explosive device (IED) in Lamu. The lorry was carrying officers from the Rapid Deployment Unit when it drove over the IED. The area is regarded dangerous as it has many Al Shabaab militants. GARISA COUNTY: A soldier (KDF) was killed and six of his colleagues injured on Monday, 23/11/2015, morning after their vehicle hit an explosive device in Hulugho. MANDERA COUNTY: A driver was injured on Wednesday (5/11/2014) morning in Mandera town after an explosive device planted on the road under construction went off.
